

Monticello Sports Expectations/Requirements for Academics and Discipline

Academics: Respect and Work completion

- Expectation: Students will maintain a weekly score of 2.5 or higher. Students that do not maintain these scores will be placed on an academic contract.
 - Students that receive a 2.5 or higher for the first three consecutive weeks of eligibility checks will be removed from the weekly checks.
 - If a teacher or coach is concerned about a student that has been removed from eligibility checks, he/she can request a student be added back.
- Contracts:
 - Students with a score of 2.4 or below are placed on Level 1 Probation.
- Timeframe for improvement:
 - Students that have improved their grades to a 2.5 or higher within 1 week of being placed on probation will be removed from restrictions.
 - Students that do not improve their grades to all passing within 1 week of being placed on probation will move to the next level of probation.
- Repeat Academic Issues
 - If a student's scores have dropped below a 2.5 after previously being released from probation, they will return to the previous level of probation.
- Dismissal from team
 - If students are unable to raise their scores within the timeframes specified, they will be dismissed from the team. Students will meet with the Coach and Athletic Director to discuss the situation and performance expectations. The Athletic Director may choose to create an Academic or Behavior contract and reinstate the student at their discretion.
- Academic Probation Levels
 - Level 1: Students are fully able to participate in athletics and will improve their grades within 1 week.
 - Level 2: Students are able to practice, but may not compete until scores improve and will improve their scores within 1 week of being placed on probation.
 - Level 3: Students are not able to practice or compete. Students are expected to raise their scores within one week.

Wednesday School/ Early Release Wednesdays: All athletes are required to stay at school on Wednesdays from 1:25 until Practice. During this time, athletes will have the opportunity to catch up on schoolwork or participate in activities with their team. Practice will begin and end at the regular scheduled time.

Referrals:

Major Referrals: Fighting, Disrespect, Defiance, Skipping, Profanity, etc.

- 1st Referral: No practice/competition on day(s) that referral/suspension is determined
- 2nd Referral: No practice/competition on day(s) that referral/suspension is determined
- 3rd Referral: One week suspension from practice & competition or duration of suspension whichever is longer. Behavior Contract created by AD.
- Further Referrals: refer to behavior contract.

Drugs/Alcohol/Tobacco/Vape

- Smoking/Vaping - Nicotine
 - 1st Offense: No practice/competition day of referral or suspension
 - 2nd Offense: Out for 20 Days or Half of Season
 - 3rd Offense: Out for remainder of season
- Drugs/Alcohol/Vaping - Marijuana
 - 1st Offense: Out for 20 Days or Half of Season
 - 2nd Offense: Out for remainder of season
